ELIGIBILITY: This event is open to all USJI, USJF and USJA members. A current membership card or proof of registration (Primary Membership) from the USJI, USJF or a current USJA registration card showing insurance coverage will be required to participate and must be displayed to the registration personnel at the time that the contestant registers. If an individual cannot produce their current membership card or proof of current membership, they must purchase membership in either USJI or USJF in order to participate. Responsibility for reimbursement of membership fees for those who have previously registered remains that of the individual.

Family rate for two or more is \$20 per contestant (Must be in the same immediate family)

FORMAT: **Pool system.** Various age, weight and rank categories to be determined by the Tournament Director to optimize competition and safety. There will be no mixed male/female pools. All matches "Stop Time" clock stops on matte.

CONTEST RULES:

Current IJF Contest Rules **Modified** as follows:

1. No *Double Knee Drop Seoinage* (Shoulder throw) will be allowed for contestants 12 years old and under. If any pool has a contestant under the age of 13 yrs. old double knee drop seoinage will not be allowed for all contestants in that pool.
2. No *Shime Waza* (Choking techniques) for 12 years old and under. If any pool has a contestant under the age of 13 yrs. old, no shime waza will be allowed for all contestants in that pool.
3. *Kansetsu Waza* (Joint lock techniques) will be allowed in the Black Belt division only. (Ikkyu brown belts may compete in this division if certificate regarding non-black belt contestant is signed by the Judo Instructor of a rank of Shodan or higher.)
4. *Waki Gatame* will not be allowed from a standing position.
5. Pre-1994 contest rules will be used for the safety zone and out of bounds area.
6. The current IJF medical rules will be modified so that a doctor may provide treatment on the mat without penalizing the competitor. However the two medical time out rule will still be in place and enforced.
7. The time limit for the golden score will be 1 minute for juniors and 2 minutes for all other groups.

SCORING SYSTEM:

Places will be determined according to the following criteria, in this order for juniors, 12 yrs. and under:

1. The most points;
2. If the number of points are tied, the most wins;
3. If two contestants are tied in points and wins - then revert to result of head to head match; whoever won the match between them will be given the higher place or if the two contestants have not competed, they will be given the option to compete, if the sizes are not that different. If this situation arises and there is a question about this, consult with the Tournament Director.
4. In all other cases not covered by these rules, consult with the Tournament Director.
5. For all other groups (Intermediates,Seniors) the first two criteria will be reversed. Wins will be the primary criteria followed by points.

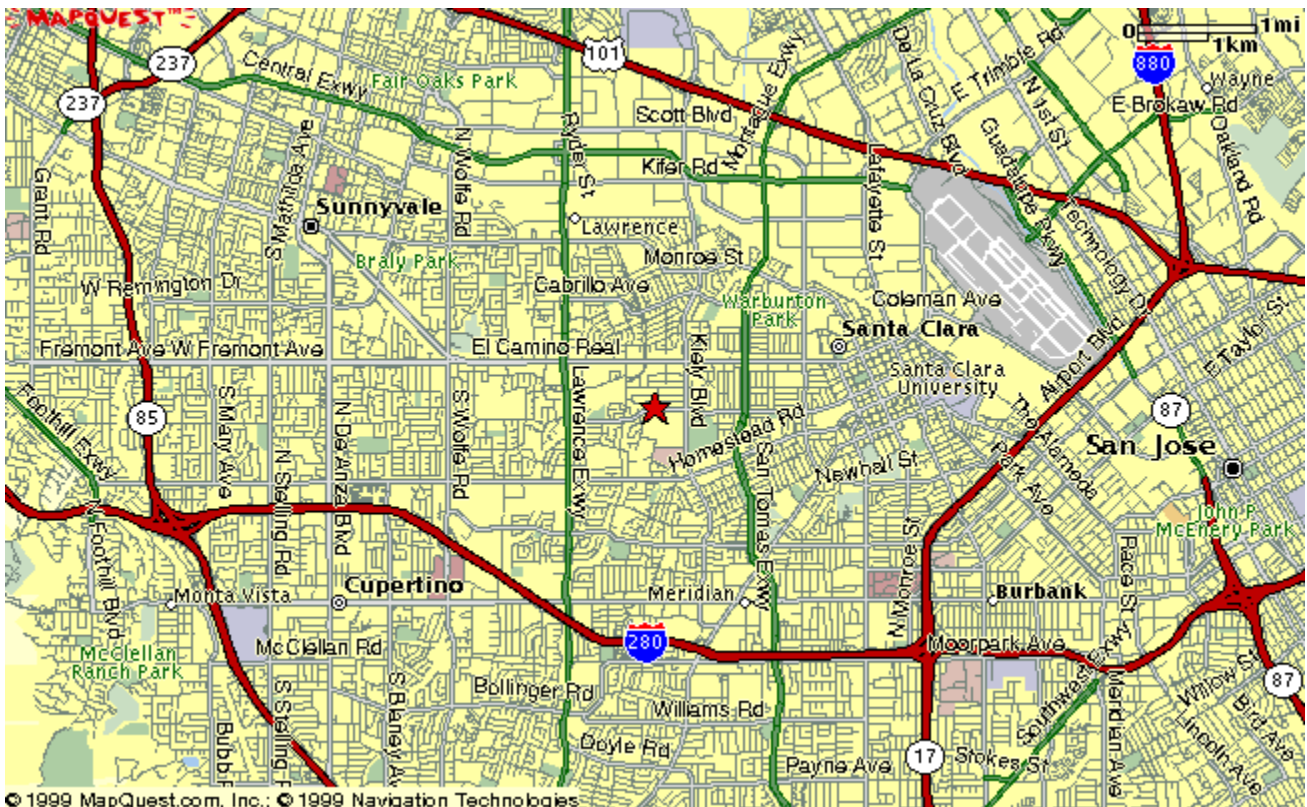
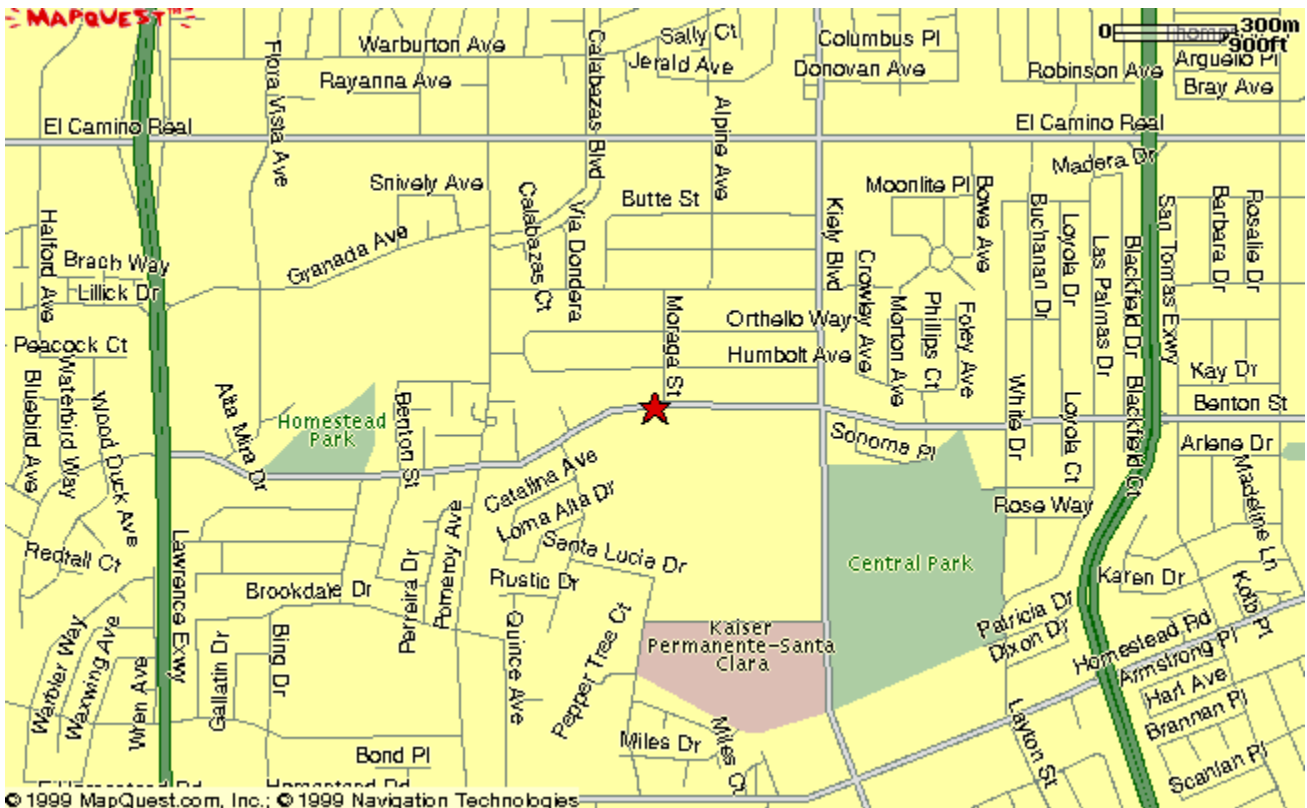
POINT SYSTEM:

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE

In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way, including travel to and from, in any Judo tournament, practice, clinic, and related events and activities (“Activity”) of the **United States Judo Federation, Inc., USA Judo/United States Judo, Inc., United States Judo Association, Inc., Hokka Judo Yudanshakai, Inc., Northern California Judo Association, Inc., Santa Clara PAL Judo Club, Santa Clara Police Department, Santa Clara Unified School District, and the Santa Clara High School**, I agree:

1. I understand the nature of Judo activities and believe I am qualified to participate in such Activity. I also understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.

2. I further acknowledge that prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment, facilities, competition pools or divisions, and the elimination or scoring system to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor, and/or a tournament official of such conditions and refuse to participate.

3. I acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, illness or disease, including permanent disability or death, and severe social and economic losses due not only to my own actions, inactions or negligence, but also to the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules of the sport of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, I acknowledge that there may be other risks not known to me or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.

4. Knowing the risks involved in the sport of Judo, I assume all such risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, illness, disease, permanent disability, or death.
