Our organization is made up of over 50 different judo clubs or dojos with a membership of over 1,600.

To apply for membership, you will have to fill out the following forms:

1. New Club Membership Application. Please print clearly and fill all the required information. Please note, the head instructor must be a registered black belt and he/she must also be a registered member with USJF. A copy of his/her black belt certificate must be attached. Also required are 3 recommendations from 3 Nanka Member Clubs. Their recommendations can be attached or they can make their recommendations in person, at the next Nanka meeting. Upon receiving your application, I will contact you once I have reviewed your application and find all the required information has been presented and inform you of the next Nanka meeting. At that time, I will make the presentation (of your application to join Nanka) to the board. At that time, you will be asked to be present and make any further presentation to the board.
2. USJF Club Registration & Insurance Application. This form is also required to be filled out completely. Once the board approves the acceptance of your club into Nanka, this form is sent to the USJF National Office.

The total fee required with the application is \$75.00. Please make the check out to Nanka Yudanshakai.
